

PLAN AHEAD

Make sure you have plenty of snow melt pellets, shovels and proper outer-wear. If you own a snow blower, make sure you have it serviced and working properly. Fill up the gas can to ensure a good supply of fuel.



Keep the elderly and infirm in mind when severe weather hits our area. Check in on home bound neighbors to make sure they are OK.



Clear snow from around fire hydrants to assist the Fire Department in case of a fire emergency.



STAY SAFE

Do not allow children to play in snow mounds near the street.

Stand back when plows come through your neighborhood. Plow trucks are heavy machines which cannot stop quickly. Drivers are sent out to get the job done efficiently and safely. Do not try to stop and speak with the drivers—call the office with any issues.

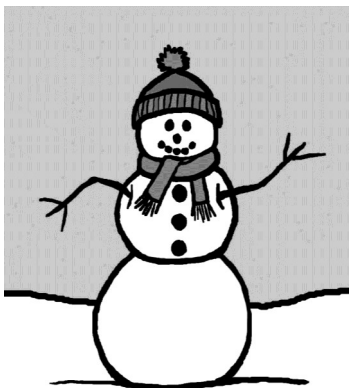
SNOW EMERGENCIES

Off-Street Parking

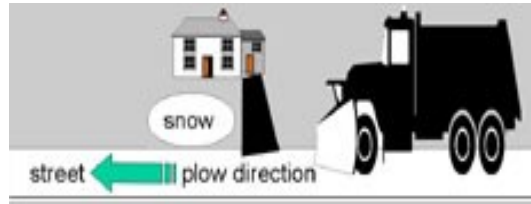
To assist snow and ice removal, the Upper Dublin Police Department requests that during snow emergencies all residents use off-street parking for vehicles.

Residents without off-street parking should follow this schedule: on even numbered days parking is permitted on the side of the street with even numbered houses; on odd numbered days parking is permitted on the side of the street with odd numbered houses. **Ordinance #656 will be strictly enforced!**

PA TURNPIKE COMMISSION is responsible for snow and ice control as well as road repairs on the Turnpike. Call 1-800-331-3414 to report hazardous conditions on the turnpike.



SNOW REMOVAL



Reduce the amount of snow that lands in your driveway, shovel a large space on both sides of your driveway for snow to fall off the plow, instead of in your driveway.

Residents are reminded that sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice within 24 hours of the end of a winter storm in accordance with Township Code. It is illegal to shovel, plow or blow snow onto a street in accordance with Ordinance #1062. Please use proper snow etiquette by removing all trash carts and other obstacles in the street.

To reduce the possibility of damage to your mailbox by the snowplow, check with the Public Works Dept. to be sure that your mailbox is installed at the proper height and set back from the street. Also, please consider removing the box from the post before major snow storms.

Plows start on State Roads then on through roads, development roads, cul-de-sacs and no outlet streets, then undedicated roads as permitted.
