Yard Waste Collection To Wednesdays Starting 8/3/22

Beginning Wednesday 8/3/22, yard waste collection will change from Friday to Wednesday. The last Friday pickup will be Friday 7/29/22. Collection will now be fully automated which will mean new procedures to collection. Procedure Change: Only yard waste contained in the township-provided green yard waste carts will be collected. No material outside or protruding from the top of the cart will be collected. Additional carts can be purchased for \$65 from the township: call 215-643-1600 ext 0. If a holiday falls on a Wednesday it will be picked up on Saturday. Temporarily during the remainder of the 2022 yard waste collection program, the 1st and 3rd Mondays each month will be added to yard waste collection. But you must schedule it by noon the Friday before pickup. Call 215-643-1600.

PFAS Study Update



Participants in the study will be compensated as follows: An adult participant who completes all components will receive \$50 in gift cards; child participants who complete all components will receive \$75 in gift cards. In addition, participants will receive information on the level of PFAS in their blood and their health test results that they can share with healthcare providers. The study is still recruiting adults who are age 18 and older and children ages 4 through 17.
